The nominee must:

1. Have a desire to continue his/her education in college in the field of Law Enforcement.

2. Be a registered, active Explorer in good standing, of a chartered Sheriff's Explorer unit.

3. Be a member of the Florida Sheriff's Explorer Association for one (1) year or more.

4. Turn in your <u>completed application</u> before the strike of the gavel at the March Delegate meeting.

5. Be present at the June State Convention for an oral interview or notify a member of the scholarship committee if you cannot be present, in advance of the June meeting.

6 The Nominee must submit to the scholarship committee no later than December 31 of the year <u>selected</u>, appropriate documentation of registration in college, such as a letter of acceptance, etc. Failure to comply will result in the nominee forfeiting the scholarship and funds available for this award.

7. The Chairman of the scholarship committee will send a letter of acceptance to the recipients' Senior Advisor (by registered mail) by July 1 of this year.

NOTE: The F.S.E.A. scholarship must be presented to a high school senior or college student and not to any person over 21 years of age.
